

Product Reference Guide Flexible IV Container Adding a Medication

- > The flexible plastic container is fabricated from a specially formulated polyvinylchloride.
- > Water can permeate from inside the container into the overwrap but not in amounts sufficient to affect the solution significantly.
- > Additives may be incompatible. Consult with pharmacist, if available.

To Add a Medication: (Use aseptic technique)



1. Prepare additive port.



- 2. Using aseptic technique and an additive delivery needle of appropriate length, puncture resealable additive port at the target area, inner diaphragm, and inject.
- 3. Withdraw needle after injecting the medication.

- 4. The additive port may be protected by covering with an additive cap.
- 5. Mix container contents thoroughly. Do not store.
